Specific Rules & Eligibility Requirements

1. Applicant must be currently enrolled as a member of their local Idaho FFA Chapter and the Idaho FFA Association, be a current high school senior, and have a minimum 2.0 GPA.
2. Applicants will receive equal consideration regardless if they are attending an in-state or out-of-state institution, or whether the institution is a university, college or vocational/technical school.
3. Scholarships will be awarded to students with declared majors in the field of agriculture.

Idaho FFA Foundation Scholarship Raffle



To be awarded:

- 15 - \$1,000 Tractor Raffle Scholarships
- 2- \$2,000 Agricultural Education Scholarships

A special thank you goes to Sid Freeman of Caldwell for continuing the Tractor Raffle Project and the Scholarship Program for the past 10 years, to the Idaho FFA Alumni who are assisting with this project and the scholarship selection process, and to FFA Chapters all over the state who are working hard to ensure the success of the Tractor Raffle and this valuable scholarship program.

Specific Rules & Eligibility Requirements

1. If a student applies for a \$2,000 Agricultural Education Scholarship but does not receive one, they will still be considered in the regular scholarship pool for the \$1,000 scholarships.
2. The Agriculture education scholarship is designed for students who want to pursue an Agriculture Education degree. Scholarship funds for the Ag Ed scholarship are issued in the following manner: \$500 Fall Sophomore Semester, \$500 Fall Junior Semester, \$500, Fall Senior Semester and \$500 Student Teaching Semester. If a student applies for the Ag Ed scholarship the Idaho FFA Foundation will ask for a degree audit to ensure the student is showing progress towards an Agriculture Education degree. If progress is not shown towards this degree the student forfeits the entire scholarship amount.
3. Applicant must be currently enrolled as a member of their local Idaho FFA Chapter and the Idaho FFA Association, be a current high school senior, and have a minimum 2.0 GPA.
4. Applicants will receive equal consideration regardless if they are attending an in-

state or out-of-state institution, or whether the institution is a university, college or vocational/technical school. Students majoring in all fields of study are eligible to apply.

5. A minimum of 1 scholarship will be issued per FFA District

6. Students must be from a chapter that participated in the previous year's program. Only students from the following chapters are eligible for a Tractor Raffle scholarship this year:

The United Dairymen of Idaho (UDI) was established in 1980 to provide Idaho's dairy farm families with resources to support a prosperous Idaho dairy industry. In 2017, UDI transitioned to Dairy West – the future of Idaho's dairy checkoff program.

Dairy West whose mission is “creating a world where farmers and the dairy industry prosper and, together, build healthy communities around the globe,” is a USDA qualified program based in Meridian and continues the marketing and promotion work for Idaho's dairy farm families. This is an exciting evolution in the nation-wide checkoff system, and Dairy West will work side-by-side with the Idaho Dairy Products Commission, fulfilling the mission of ensuring the prosperous future of dairy farming in the west.

Specific Rules & Eligibility Requirements

1. Applicant must be a current or former Idaho FFA member as verified by the chapter advisor, be a current high school senior or a current undergraduate or graduate college student, and have a minimum 3.0 GPA.
2. Scholarships may be awarded to students attending the University of Idaho, Utah State University, Oregon State University, Washington State University, Brigham Young University, or Brigham Young University-Idaho.

3. Scholarships will be awarded to students in majors and planned career paths in the dairy cattle production or dairy food science areas.

4. Direct relatives of FFA staff, Dairy West staff, or those on the selection committee are not eligible.

With the alarming loss of farmland and fewer dairy farms in the Treasure Valley, the intent of this scholarship is to support young people who want to pursue an education in Agriculture and especially Dairy related fields.

Specific Rules & Eligibility Requirements

1. Applicant must be a current or former FFA member of the
 - a. Boise Valley District
(Kuna, Melba, Meridian, Nampa, Rimrock, Mountain Home) or
 - b. Treasure Valley District
(Caldwell, Homedale, Marsing, Middleton, Notus, Ridgevue, Vallivue, Wilder)be a current high school senior or a current undergraduate or graduate college student and have a minimum 3.0 GPA, unweighted.
2. Scholarships will be granted to high school seniors with declared majors in, and college students currently enrolled in Animal Science, Pre-Vet, Food Science or in the field of Agriculture with preference to those in dairy science-related majors.
3. Applicants attending in-state institutions (Colleges, Universities, or Vocational/Technical schools) will receive preference; however, applicants

attending in-state or out-of-state institutions will be considered and final scholarship determination made on the overall application.

- 2-\$2,000 scholarship to a member of a Canyon County Chapter
- 1-\$2,000 scholarship to a member from any Idaho FFA chapter

** If enough qualified applicants from Canyon County FFA Chapters are not identified, that designated scholarships may be awarded to other FFA members from any FFA Chapter from throughout Idaho at the discretion of the scholarship committee.*

Specific Rules & Eligibility Requirements

1. Applicant must be currently enrolled as a member of their local FFA Chapter and the Idaho FFA Association, be a **current high school senior**, and have a **minimum 3.0 GPA**, unweighted.
2. Scholarships will be granted to high school seniors with **declared majors in Animal Science, Pre-Vet, Food Science, or the field of Agriculture** with preference to those in animal science-related majors.
3. Applicants attending in-state institutions will receive preference; however, applicants attending in-state or out-of-state institutions will be considered and final scholarship determination will be made on the overall application by the scholarship judging committee.
